

The Dawley Food Bank will not be doing Christmas Hampers and Gifts this year.

As from May 2024, the Dawley Food Bank has made a few changes. The Food Bank used to support families for as long as they believed clients needed them, but a new policy has been introduced which means clients can have up to 6 food parcels, which gives them time to sort their benefits.

The Food Bank found that clients had become dependant on them and long term this isn't sustainable, as the food and money that is received, isn't as much as it used be.

Also, this year the Food Bank has decided not to do the Christmas hampers and toys. We will of course be generous and provide our clients with selection boxes and a few Christmas goodies, but we will leave the hampers to other organisations to provide.

We are accepting donations of brand new toys which will be passed on to CAP (Christian Against Poverty) which are based in All Saints Church, Wellington, as they are doing hampers and toys for their clients and we work together wherever possible.

Circuit Service on Sunday 3rd November 2024



Listen Carefully

Can you Listen carefully to someone who is troubled, listen without judgement and without telling them what they should do? Listen compassionately and try to understand the circumstances from their point of view and then help them to work out their own solution?

The people you will listen to come from many walks of life but there are often reasons why they come to the Dawley Food Bank apart from just 'running out of money at the end of the month'. They may be vulnerable victims of violence or other crime, they may have housing problems or be in debt. They may have mental health problems, have been released from prison or have addiction problems.

Your role would not be to find a solution for them but help them to find their own, maybe through you signposting them to other organisations or maybe by talking through the options that they have thought about. And just to keep them going, you can offer them a food parcel to last the next week.

If you can do these things and you are available to volunteer at Dawley Christian Centre on a Monday, Wednesday or Friday morning (10:30 to 12:30) then we would like to talk to you and invite you to see what we do at the food bank.
