



Ministry Update



Fatima left her country to protect her family from an ongoing war. She soon found one of OM's partners, a church-run community centre that distributes food weekly to refugees. Fatima started coming each week to collect food and stayed to receive prayer. Soon, she started bringing some of her friends along, others who has escaped the war.

One day, Fatima shyly invited one of the volunteers to her home. When she and a friend arrived at the home, six of Fatima's neighbours were waiting for them in the small living room! "I invited my neighbours so that you can pray for them!" she said. This was the start to weekly visits and telling Bible stories to about 15 ladies.

Then these ladies started having dreams and visions of Jesus. "What does my dream mean?" they would ask. The volunteers would listen and explain their dreams and tell them more about Jesus.

"Jesus is calling you." They told one of the ladies, "When you are ready to accept him, we would love to pray for you." She very quickly accepted. Then her sister came to faith, then another lady, and another....
